Dr. Donaldson has served in the Rotary Club of Calgary and a highlight of June's career was participating in the Canadian Prime Minister's Task Force on Women Entrepreneurs. June has received many recognitions, some of which have been nominations for the Calgary Chamber Small Business Owner of the Year award, the Canadian Women Entrepreneur of the Year, and twice as a YWCA Woman of Distinction.

Dr. June's most recent board experience, and one that gave her great joy, was with the Seabiscuit Heritage Foundation in Willits, California. June was a driving force in having an Edmonton street named after the Edmonton born jockey, John (Red) M. Pollard, of the legendary racehorse, Seabiscuit; Seabiscuit's stud barn recognized as a US national historic site; and Santa Anita Park in Arcadia, California host a 75th anniversary celebration of Seabiscuit and Pollard winning the coveted \$100,000.00 Santa Anita Handicap on March 2, 1940. That major achievement, after both man and horse came back from catastrophic injury, resulted in them breaking the track record (which stood for a decade).
